Our commitments

We may be a small company, but we are mighty in our ambition to make a positive change in everything that we do.

We are dedicated to creating meaningful impact for our people, our communities and the environment. We have set out seven core commitments that guide our approach to corporate responsibility and help us play our part in creating a better world.

1. Employee wellbeing

The wellbeing of our people is a top priority. We believe that when individuals feel supported, valued and empowered, they are more likely to thrive both personally and professionally.

We are genuinely committed to creating a positive, healthy and supportive working environment, including safe spaces where people feel able to open up and seek support. Our approach to wellbeing has been recognised externally: we were honoured to win the Workplace Wellbeing Award at the Mental Health and Wellbeing Wales Awards 2022 and to achieve Silver in the Mind Workplace Wellbeing Index 2023. These awards reflect the dedication of our Wellbeing team, our Mental Health First Aiders and the thoughtful initiatives we have in place to support our people.

2. Equality, diversity and inclusion (ED&I)

We are deeply committed to embracing and celebrating difference, valuing diversity and promoting inclusion. At CMC, everyone is encouraged to bring their whole self to work, with their unique perspectives, experiences and talents welcomed and respected.

We believe that by appreciating and championing these differences, we create a stronger, more inclusive organisation where people can do their best work and thrive together.

3. The environment

We are a net zero company and take our environmental responsibilities seriously. Our carbon reduction programme focuses on embedding sustainable practices across the business, including supporting flexible and remote working to reduce travel and associated emissions.

We are a Living Wage Employer and accredited by the Living Wage Foundation. We are proud of our commitment to paying our people fairly, in line with the real cost of living.

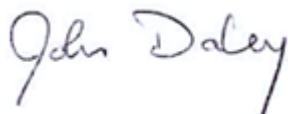
7. Fair payment
